A classic mature Rioja, aged for 3 and a half years, with the developed baked fruit, coffee and sweet spice character.

Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Jomard, Pierre Dupond, France

40

Traditional winemaking is practiced to produce wines that reflective the region, showing violet, blackcurrant and cherry.

Château du Breuil, Haut-Médoc France

42

Established in the 6th century, the Baronnie du Breuil is the oldest vineyard in the Médoc region. A classic Cabernet/Merlot blend aged for about a year in oak barrels.

Fleurie Poncereau, Louis Jadot France

45

Aged in oak to add complexity to this mellow, but also racy wine, with a silky texture and plenty of ripe red fruit.

Côte de Beaune-Villages, Bouchard Aîné & Fils, France

The Pinot Noir for this elegant, soft wine is matured in barrels for 12 months, showing red and black berry fruit on the nose and a note of vanilla on the palate.

Barolo, Enrico Serafino Italy

60

Aged for 3 years this is a big, wellstructured red with a racy tannins, fresh red fruit and spicy notes of liquorice and vanilla. Nebiollo primary grape.

Sancerre Rouge, Le Connétable de Joseph Mellot, France

65

Pinot Noir grapes show blackberry and spicy-oak notes on the nose; the palate is smooth and round on the finish.

Nuits-Saint-Georges, Louis Jadot, France

85

Pinot Noir at its most rich and complex with aromas of bramble fruits and a savoury spice character that will work with everything from wild mushrooms to red meats.

Le Altane Prosecco Extra Dry Italy 30

Refreshing citrus and pear flavours, with soft, appealing bubbles.

Bottega Poeti Rosé Prosecco DOC 34 Italy

Offering the same approachable, easydrinking style of white Prosecco, with the attractive addition of summer fruit flavours.

Camel Valley Brut, 59 England
